However, there may be substance abuse violations by them when they are holding office and suspicion or reports on any of the elected student representatives may surface. Point Discussed Proposal for a Committee to look into allowing candidates that don't meet the CGPA criteria to stand for elections: Currently: All candidates standing for student elections should have a CGPA of 7 or above.
