
Dear Students,

The IIT Madras Campus sits on 512 acres, 2.5 km² located in the centre of the city, 12.5 Kilometres from the airport and 10 Kilometres from Central Central Railway Station. It is located on the Sanjur Patel Road, between the Raj Bhavan and the Adyar Bus Terminus.



IIT MADRAS HAS THREE GATES:

- Main Gate, on the Sanjur Patel Road
- Veterinary Gate (only for pedestrians / two - wheeler vehicles), on the G.V. Ramaiah College road
- Tambaram Gate (only for pedestrians / Two - wheeler vehicles).

The campus is connected to the IIT Madras Research Park [IITMRP] through the IITM Academic Bridge.



TO-AND-FRO FROM CAMPUS

Bus: IIT Madras is connected to the Chennai Railway Station and other major and minor bus routes. Mother Teresa, the C.R.I./Cancer Institute are the bus stops near the Main Gate. Gopalapuram and Anna University College is the bus stop near the Veterinary Research Institute. Buses are available for the Chennai Metrobus (Tamil Nadu TMB), Revomod. For bus route information, visit the MTC website.

MRTS: East and West station (near Tidel Park) is at about 1.5 km from the Main Gate.

Chennai Metro: The Metro (Subramaniyan and Tatyasaheb) metro stations are about 2-3 km away by road.

Local Train: Local trains are also available from Ghatkopar (3.3 km). Outstation trains are available from the Chennai Central Railway Station and Egmore Station.

Autos and Taxis: The city is well served by autos and taxis and common cab sharing app can be used.

On-Campus Bus Transport:

a) On-campus bus service is available for all on all days from 6:15 am to 9:30 pm at an interval of 15 minutes. The buses start at 6:15 am from the Main Gate to the Bus Depot and from the Bus Depot to the Main Gate. The last bus returns to the main gate at 10:00 pm to the Bus Depot via Egmore Circle(GO).

The bus fare per person is 50/- from the Academic Zone to the Bus Depot and one time between 50/- per person and 50/- sum in case of a student. It can be availed by visiting <http://www.iitm.ac.in> or calling the bus service.



MAJOR LANDMARKS (in Alphabetic Order)

Administration Block: It is close to the Galendra Circle (GCI). Academic Section, Academic Research Section, Administration section, Accounts Section, Engineering Unit offices, Faculty Section, Library Section are located in this block.

Ajanta: A 24/7 Reading Hall is located at Central Library

Bose Einstein Guest House (BEGH): It provides boarding & lodging facilities for VIPs and Institute Guest.

Career Pathway Centre: It is to empower students to independently manage and execute their career goals. Located to the East office.



Central Electronic Centre (CEC): Electronic laboratories are situated at CEC. CEC is located at Electrical Sciences Block.

Central Lecture Theatre (CLT): The airconditioned lecture theatre is located in the block of the Administration, in the Humanities and Sciences block. It is often used as the venue for quizzes, special lectures, cultural activities and more.

Central Library: This five storied building is home to a large number of books and journals and it's located close to the Galendra circle. It also has a book bank where one can borrow and issue for a semester.

Central Skill Training and Fabrication Facility (CSTF): CSTF is located on 41 mm Avenue, opposite to the Mechanical Sciences Block.

Disco Room complex (DRC): Dr. Alamelu Avenue, it is situated half-way between the Humanities and Sciences Block (HSS) and the Velachery Gate. The majority of first year students stay here.



Dining Facility:

Tempesta Mess - situated on the first floor

Nigri Mess - Near Krishna Hostel

Vandya Mess - Near Sharavati Hostel

Discovery Campus: Discovery campus at Thirupur (160 acres) is situated 30 km from the main Campus. It will host state-of-the-art research centres with large dedicated facilities.

Block: Interim place located next to the building of the Department of Management Studies (DMS).

Food for Thoughts (FFT): This is the Food court facility on the first floor of Campus Cafe.

Gajendra Circle (GC): This is the primary intersection and the key reference point for moving around campus.



Heritage Centre: is located on the front side of the Administrative Block-Ground floor.

iCASK Building: This is located opposite to the Administrative Building on Alankar Avenue. It houses Auditorium, Seminar Halls, Conference Rooms and offices of Dean CSR and Dean ARI, besides other facilities.

IT Marines Research Park (ITMRP): ITMRP provides an ecosystem for Academic-industry collaboration with over 1000 firms on 19600 sq feet up facilities. ITMRP is situated in the ITB campus vicinity.

Institute Hospital: provides primary health care services. Hospital is located on the cross road.



Krishna Chitukula Block: Earlier known as NAC I, it is a multi storied building housing several departments and offices.

Manohar C Watsa Stadium: This large open air stadium is situated in Delhi Avenue and is used for various sports activities, art shows during Sroostha, and more.

New Academic Complex-II (NAC - II): New Academic Complex-II is located adjacent to the building of the Department of Ocean Engineering and opposite to the building of Biotechnology I.

Office of the Dean of Students (ODS): It is situated adjacent to the west end of the Administration Building. It houses Wellness Centre on the 1st floor, Dean Students' Office on the 2nd floor and a multi-purpose Utility Hall (UTI) on the 3rd floor.

Office of Hostel Management (OHM): Takes care of various Hostel Accommodation / Dining related activities. It is located on the SAC road.

Open Air Theatre (OAT): It is an amphitheatre where the Film Club shows movies every Saturday. It is situated between the GT and the bus stop area. It hosts professional shows at the time of Samskruthi besides many other events and activities.



Quark: Student activities space near Samskruthi centre. A restaurant is located in the ground floor. BII lounge for student events has been located on the 1st floor.

Banerji and Ramanujan Blocks: These are the places where most of your common classes will take place and where most of you will be headed to in the mornings, half awake. The ground floor of the Class Room Complex is air conditioned and is open for the use of students till 1 AM during the cult weeks to serve as hangout spots for the maddu jungs apart from the library.

Security Section: The main office of security section is located in the back side of the Administration Block, Ground Floor.



Students' Activity Centre (SAC): The registration for Admissions will be conducted in this building. It has a music room, a large auditorium and more. Important events like Institute Day and Convocation are held here.

Sudha and Shankar Innovation Hub: A science segment in the Institute devoted

Taramani Guest House (TGH): Provides lodging and boarding facilities for guest & Faculty/staff/students.

Up-Top Interaction Lounge (UTI): UTI is located on the roof-top of the 1st Building. The space is well utilised for the interaction meetings.

Wellness Centre: Institute has Wellness Centre where students can consult mental health professionals. It is situated in the premises of the R&D building (1st floor).





Canara Bank: It is located near the shopping center close to the residential areas. The bank has two ATMs – one is located within the premises and the other at Student Facilities Centre.




ICICI Bank ATMs: One is located at Office of Hostel Management and the other at Near Nilgiri Mess.


